- The Sport Touring route includes scenic north Georgia mountain roads. The route is suitable for all touring and sport touring motorcycles. A tank bag map holder for the route sheet is recommended.
- The **Dual Sport / Adventure Touring** route will include scenic dirt and gravel roads in the National Forest. The gravel roads will be suitable for experienced dual sport riders on all sizes of adventure and dual sport motorcycles, including large bikes like BMW GS and Suzuki V-Strom. Aggressive dual sport tires are recommended. A dual-sport type route sheet roll holder or a tank bag map holder will come in handy! Route sheet roll holders will be available for purchase at registration.
- Any rider under age 18 must have a parent present at registration to sign liability waivers.
